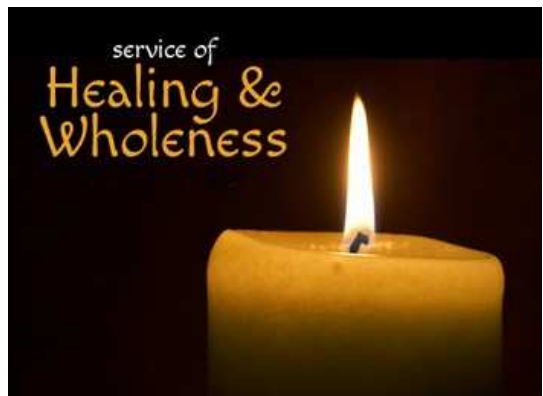

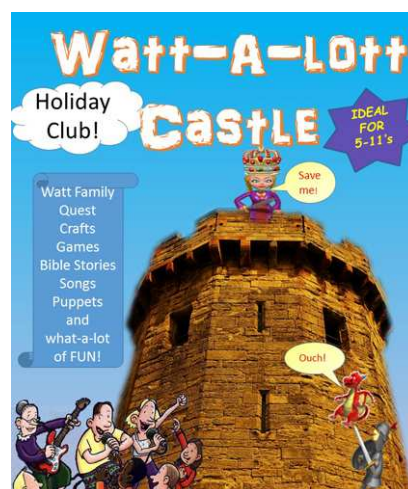
Sorry it is not so appetising as Pringles but I'm sure as a Mission Area we can meet our target!!
